Synopsis

Kaden is in their mid-20s, living in a 5-person share house in Melbourne's inner North. Kaden is living with a disability, and attempting to navigate the NDIS system with the help of their friend, Tess.

Resilience shows a moment in their life at home. They have a conversation on the phone with Tess, who cancels dinner plans. This means Kaden can stay in bed until she arrives. Lee, their housemate, comes into their room and they hang out in a comfortable, familial way. Kaden stays in bed and Lee heads into the living room to have dinner with the rest of their housemates; Loz, Max and Gem.
